Witness	Financial Giving	Service

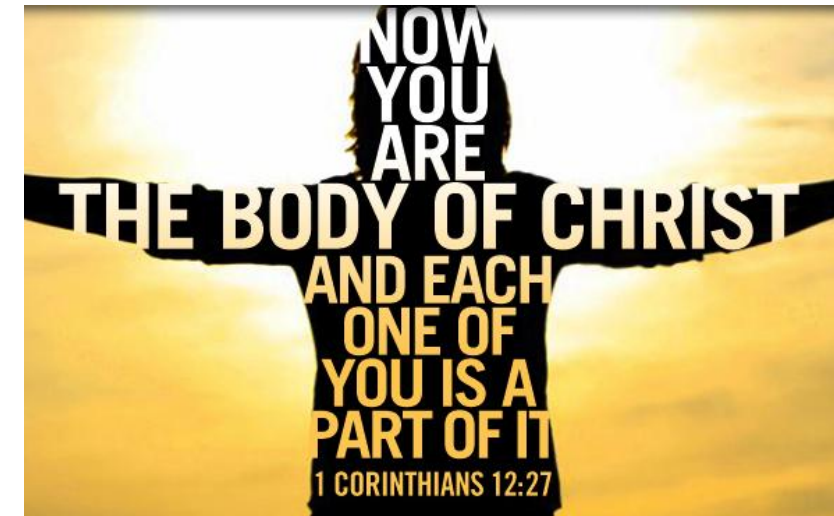
