- The stories we hear from our ramp recipients and their family members are moving tales of transformation: depression lifted with increased independence; dignity restored by not having to resort to being dragged up and down the steps to exit and enter their home; reconnection with other family members with mobility issues; a renewed sense of belonging in one's community.
